8. **Provide a nutritious, well-balanced snack & lunch** for your child each day, understanding that the school does not offer a lunch program.
9. **Maintain open, respectful communication** with PRP staff and fellow families to foster a collaborative and connected school culture.
10. **Acknowledge that extended family members and/or volunteers** (e.g., grandparents, aunts, uncles) who may volunteer at PRP must meet the same expectations of safety and character. By signing below, you confirm that any family members assisting at PRP **have no felonies or charges that would endanger children** in any way.
11. **Recognize that PRP is not a special education provider.** If your child has a diagnosed learning difference or special learning need, it is the **parent's responsibility to lead and support their child's plan.** PRP will help facilitate collaboration with outside partners or public-school resources (such as NCSD/IEP) to support the student; however, PRP does not administer or oversee special education services.
12. **Understand that student success at PRP is measured through a balance of assessments, daily engagement, character and overall growth.** While we incorporate academic Knowledge Quests, we will not "teach to the test," but instead focus on developing lifelong learners.
13. **We have full legal custody/authority to enroll the student.**
